The IUOE Local 57 Apprenticeship Program is recruiting apprentices to the heavy equipment operation and repair trade. Applications must be completed in-person from June 10, 2019 through June, 14 2019, 9:00am -12:00pm at 873 Central Avenue in Johnston, RI 02919. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age, and provide documentation of:

- High School Diploma / GED
- High School Transcript
- Social Security Card (not a copy)
- Three Signed Letters of Reference (not from family)
- Birth Certificate
- Driver's License
- Copy of DD-214 (Veterans only)

You have 7 days from the date of your application to return all necessary documents listed above. Completed applications will move onto the next steps of the selection procedure including: state aptitude test, interview process and drug testing (pre-screening and random). You will be notified following your application submission.

This Apprenticeship school trains heavy equipment operators in the construction industry and will prepare apprentices with all of the knowledge and tools required for work, related licensing and certifications in the field. Local 57 upholds a high standard of membership and provides opportunity for field experience, seasoned instructors for all classes, and hands-on learning at our facility to maintain that standard.
